Pastor's Message

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday we especially celebrate the Feast of the Triumph of the Cross. This feast goes back to the seventh century when the Cross was recovered from the Persians and exposed for veneration in Jerusalem. It is more than this historic event; the Triumph of the Cross is the triumph of Jesus Christ our Lord whose love for us and obedience to his Heavenly Father climaxed with his death on the cross. Just like Moses lifted up the serpent on the cross in the desert for people's healing, Jesus would be lifted up so that all who see him and believe in him would have eternal life.

The cross is the symbol of the Christian. It is a sign of our personal relationship with our Savior. Jesus died not just for people in general but for me and for you. He calls us to join him on his cross not just as a people but as individuals, because the way of the cross is the way towards salvation. If we want to follow Jesus we have to deny ourselves, to take up our daily cross and follow him. The ideal for this is that we recognize the goal of our lives; out of love we sacrifice ourselves for others.

The deeper meaning of the Cross is presented in today's second reading from the Letter of St. Paul to the Philippians. Jesus emptied himself completely, not just becoming a human being but also accepting a horrible death on the cross in order to demonstrate the amazing love of God for us. We are saved from the horrors of evil, from meaningless lives due to the love of the Lord.

This Sunday we are to recognize the most significant symbol of the Cross. It is on the Cross, our Savior has died for our sins. It is on the Cross, our Savior has set us free from the power of darkness so that we are able to journey to our destiny. It is on the Cross, our Savior has opened the gate to heaven where we hope to join with our brothers and sisters when time comes.
